First-Year Student Applications

Incoming freshmen who are interested in the Global Entrepreneurship Experience must complete a three step application process: 1) Apply to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. This can be completed by [clicking here](#); 2) Submit the university's scholarship application on the UNLV Financial Aid and Scholarships website: <http://finaid.unlv.edu/> and 3) Once admitted to UNLV, apply to the Global Entrepreneurship Experience. There is no application submission deadline; however, students applying by February 1st will have priority consideration for the Global Entrepreneurship Experience admission and scholarships.

Application Materials

The Global Entrepreneurship Experience admissions committee reviews various elements in student records to make admissions decisions. It uses essays, letters of recommendation, accounts of extracurricular and leadership activities, grade point averages, and SAT and/or ACT scores, in addition to in-person interviews as requested. The college realizes that students have different strengths and accordingly treats each application individually.

- **Transcripts and Test Scores.** Copies of your most current high school transcript and results of national college entrance examinations (ACT and/or SAT).
- Unofficial transcripts are acceptable and can be submitted to the Global Entrepreneurship Experience office, via mail or fax to (702) 895-4090. All unofficial transcripts received by the Global Entrepreneurship Experience will ultimately be verified by official transcripts received as part of your UNLV admission process.
- As part of the application process, we require two letters of reference commenting on your academic achievement and skills, in sealed envelopes and on official stationery from instructors or counselors familiar with your academic work. E-mail letters from official educational email servers are welcome and can be sent to bges@unlv.edu. Please follow e-mail letters of reference with hard copies on school stationery.
