



2010-2011 NAWIC (National Association of Women in Construction) Construction Scholarship

Who May Apply

- Females who are pursuing a degree in one of the following programs: Construction Management or Civil or Structural Engineering at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) Howard R. Hughes College of Engineering or Architecture at the UNLV College of Fine Arts.
- Student must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative weighted GPA per semester in order to receive the scholarship awards for the next semester.
- The student must possess the minimum requirements for ranking as a junior in the fall of 2010 semester within her chosen degree program **at UNLV** (at least sixty credit hours completed by the end of spring 2010 semester.)

Award

The total potential award is \$4,000 (\$1,000 per semester for a maximum of two years, for full-time students. For part-time students the current award is \$100 per credit hour, up to 10 hours per semester, for up to two years. This award is contingent upon adherence to the scholarship requirements outlined above.

Deadline

Applications must be received in the Foundation office or postmarked by February 25, 2011.

Award

One scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded. This award is paid by semester. The recipient(s) must submit their transcript and class schedule for the upcoming semester. There will be no remainder for this. Scholarship funds must be applied toward tuition, fees and other appropriate educational expenses.

Submit the completed application package in the following order

- Include - Applicant's General Information page Financial Statement and the Certifications and Authorizations form. Also include a completed FAFSA form. Visit www.fafsa.ed.gov for the form.
- Essay - "How continuing your education will impact your life?". The length of your typed essay should be 400-500 words. Please attach additional page(s) for your essay.
- Interview will be required
- Transcript (including 7th semester grades)/Test Scores

As part of the acceptance of this scholarship, you will be required to attend the following event(s)

- The Public Education Foundation Scholarship Awards Luncheon to be held on TBA.

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Scholarship Instructions

How to Apply

The scholarship application is divided into two parts, “A” & “B”. Part “A” is an alphabetical listing of each scholarship being offered for the current school year. Read Part “A” in full as it may contain additional information or forms that need to be completed for the scholarship.

Part “B” contains the Adobe PDF application. This application is common to all **Public Education Foundation** scholarships. Each scholarship **MUST** have this form accompany it. If you are applying for multiple scholarships, you simply need to save the file to your computer and change the scholarship drop-down for each one.

Mail paper copies of your application(s) to the address below. Please put multiple applications in one flat envelope, separating each application with a paperclip. Do not fold or staple your application. *If you submit multiple applications, include enough copies of you transcripts, resumes, and letters of recommendation, etc. All documents submitted should be printed on single-sided, standard-size (8 ½ by 11”) paper.*

- Your scholarship will NOT be presented to the donor if you do not have all of the required documents for each application.
- Documents **MUST** be submitted in same order as listed on page (2) of the application.
- Unofficial-unsealed transcripts are acceptable. Must have appropriate signatures.
- Applications may also be sent through school mail or delivered to the PEF.
- Folders, report covers, etc. used to submit your application will be discarded.
