Who May Apply

High school seniors in Clark County may apply for this scholarship. This includes all CCSD high schools, charter schools, and alternative schools. Also, all private high schools are included as well as home-schooled seniors. Student must plan to attend an accredited post-secondary institution which includes colleges, universalities and trade schools. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and be involved in community service and volunteerism. Please see page two for additional eligibility requirements.

Children or grandchildren of employees or officers of NV Energy may not apply.

Award

Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be awarded to each school in Clark County with graduating seniors. One scholarship will be awarded to a home-schooled graduating senior.

Deadline

Applications must be received in the Foundation office or postmarked by March 15, 2011.

Additional requirements include:

- A U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident.
- A high school senior attending school or home schooled in Clark County.
- Have completed 20 hours of community service within the previous 12 months as validated by school counselor, agency or organization. (Volunteer service may include your work with a nonprofit agency such as a church group, Boy or Girl Scouts, Key Club, etc.)
- Have demonstrated academic success with a minimum grade point average of a minimum 3.0 GPA. (e Please include your advanced placement classes, student clubs and associations such as Debate Club and Student Government, etc.
- A goal of pursuing a degree at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Children or grandchildren of employees or officers of NV Energy may not apply.
- Scholarship applicants are evaluated on the following criteria: demonstrated leadership, commitment to community and academic achievement.

Award

Two Powerful Partnership scholarships for each Clark County high school along with one for the home schooled will be awarded. Each scholarship is for \$1,000. Verification of enrollment (class schedule is required. Also your college letter of admission.) These funds will be disbursed in equal payments over two semesters and are to be used for tuition, books, fees and other appropriate educational expenses. Any unused funds must be returned to NV Energy Foundation.

Submit the completed application package in the following order

- Include - Applicant's General Information page, Financial Statement and the Certifications and Authorizations form. Student Must include parents work location on the Financial Statement
- Essay must include a personal statement outlining career goals and aspirations. The 400-500 word essay must also include your most memorable volunteer experience. Please attach additional page(s) for your essay.
- Transcript (including 7th semester grades)/Test Scores
- Three letters of recommendation. One must be from a school official and two from volunteer agencies.
- Resume

As part of the acceptance of this scholarship, you will be required to attend the following event(s)

- The Public Education Foundation Scholarship Awards Luncheon to be held on TBA.

How to Apply

The scholarship application is divided into two parts, “A” & “B”. Part “A” is an alphabetical listing of each scholarship being offered for the current school year. Read Part “A” in full as it may contain additional information or forms that need to be completed for the scholarship.

Part “B” contains the Adobe PDF application. This application is common to all **Public Education Foundation** scholarships. Each scholarship **MUST** have this form accompany it. If you are applying for multiple scholarships, you simply need to save the file to your computer and change the scholarship drop-down for each one.

Mail paper copies of your application(s) to the address below. Please put multiple applications in one flat envelope, separating each application with a paperclip. Do not fold or staple your application. *If you submit multiple applications, include enough copies of you transcripts, resumes, and letters of recommendation, etc. All documents submitted should be printed on single-sided, standard-size (8 ½ by 11”) paper.*

- Your scholarship will NOT be presented to the donor if you do not have all of the required documents for each application.
- Documents **MUST** be submitted in same order as listed on page (2) of the application.
- Unofficial-unsealed transcripts are acceptable. Must have appropriate signatures.
- Applications may also be sent through school mail or delivered to the PEF.
- Folders, report covers, etc. used to submit your application will be discarded.
