### **Who May Apply**

---

CCSD seniors who demonstrate an interest in home building and community development and **plan to attend a Nevada accredited college or university may apply.** **Areas of study include, but are not limited to, business, civil engineering, architecture or landscape architecture and construction management.** A minimum 2.8 cumulative GPA is required. Student must attend fulltime. (Minimum 12 credit hours.)

### **Award**

---

Five scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each will be awarded. The awards may be renewable for up to three additional years for a total of \$6,000 per scholarship.

### **Deadline**

---

Applications must be received in the Foundation office or postmarked by February 25, 2011.

## **2010-2011 Pardee Homes Community Building Scholarship**

Pardee Homes Community Building Scholarship was established in 2002 in commemoration of the company's 50th anniversary of building homes and communities for some 40,000 families in the Las Vegas Valley. ### **Award**

Five scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each will be awarded. The awards may be renewable for up to three additional years for a total of \$6,000 per scholarship. Verification of enrollment (class schedule) is required. Scholarship funds must be applied toward tuition, fees and other appropriate educational expenses. These funds will be disbursed in equal payments over two semesters during each award year. Students who wish to renew their scholarship should fax a transcript with a letter of request at the end of each academic year. Transcripts must demonstrate a continued interest in the homebuilding industry. Areas of study include, but are not limited to; business, construction management, civil engineering, architecture or landscape architecture. A committee will decide if a renewal is granted. **Student must attend fulltime and must attend school in Nevada.**

### **Submit the completed application package in the following order**

- Include - Applicant's General Information page and the Certifications and Authorizations form.
- Essay - Explain the impact that the home building industry has had on Las Vegas, Nevada. The length of your typed essay should be 400-500 words. Please attach additional page(s) for your essay.
- Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, club advisor, coach or employer.
- Transcript (including 7th semester grades)/Test Scores
- Resume of awards, activities, employment and community service. Please include names and addresses of references.

### **As part of the acceptance of this scholarship, you will be required to attend the following event(s)**

- The Public Education Foundation Scholarship Awards Luncheon to be held on TBA.

## Scholarship Instructions

### How to Apply

The scholarship application is divided into two parts, “A” & “B”. Part “A” is an alphabetical listing of each scholarship being offered for the current school year. Read Part “A” in full as it may contain additional information or forms that need to be completed for the scholarship.

Part “B” contains the Adobe PDF application. This application is common to all **Public Education Foundation** scholarships. Each scholarship **MUST** have this form accompany it. If you are applying for multiple scholarships, you simply need to save the file to your computer and change the scholarship drop-down for each one.

Mail paper copies of your application(s) to the address below. Please put multiple applications in one flat envelope, separating each application with a paperclip. Do not fold or staple your application. *If you submit multiple applications, include enough copies of you transcripts, resumes, and letters of recommendation, etc. All documents submitted should be printed on single-sided, standard-size (8 ½ by 11”) paper.*

- Your scholarship will NOT be presented to the donor if you do not have all of the required documents for each application.
- Documents **MUST** be submitted in same order as listed on page (2) of the application.
- Unofficial-unsealed transcripts are acceptable. Must have appropriate signatures.
- Applications may also be sent through school mail or delivered to the PEF.
- Folders, report covers, etc. used to submit your application will be discarded.
