

## Cellular Phone Usage

Cell phone companies are currently providing a “block service” to all cell phone users. This feature allows parents to monitor their child’s cell phone usage by blocking all calls and text messages during the instructional day. Parents may select up to four (4) numbers that their child can contact during the instructional day for emergency purposes only. There is a small fee for this feature depending on your cell phone provider. SECTA staff would appreciate any assistance from parents to alleviate this situation during instructional time.

Clark County school District Policy 5136 clearly states that the use by students of personal communication devices such as cell phones, and similar electronic communication devices is prohibited at all district school campuses during the instructional day. Students may use these devices before school, during their lunch break, and while on district buses. These devices must remain off during instructional time including passing periods.

Students who violate this policy will be disciplined as provided for in Clark County School District’s Behavior Guidelines for Secondary Students and the Elementary Students Behaving Positively at School.
